- **Your own cloud backend**

A separate Firebase backend — a Realtime Database plus the Cloud Functions that run dispatch, reassignment, reminders, geofencing, and more — provisioned for your company alone.

- **Ongoing updates**

Improvements to the shared platform reach your apps as updates over the term of the license.

- **Store presence under your brand**

Your apps are published to the App Store and Google Play under your own company name and brand pack.

BRAND & DATA

Your brand, your data

One shared codebase powers every licensee, but your identity and your operational data stay separated and yours.

All licensees run on **one shared codebase**. Your company sits on top of that codebase as a **brand pack** — your name, your colors, and your app icon — so the apps look and feel like your product, not a generic one.

- **A brand pack that is yours**

Your name, colors, and icon define how the Driver and Dispatcher apps appear to your team.

- **A separate backend per company**

Each licensed company runs on its own isolated backend. Your data lives on your backend and is never mixed with another company's.

- **Your operational data is yours**

The trips, drivers, dispatch records, and client information your company generates in daily operation belong to you.

Isolation by design

Per-licensee isolation is built into how the platform is delivered — a separate backend and a separate brand pack for every company — not an add-on you have to configure.

HOW IT'S LICENSED

A license, not a sale of the code

You are licensed to use the platform to run your transportation company. You are not buying the source code.

Give access to your dispatchers and drivers so they can use the apps in the normal course of your business.

Restrictions

- **No reselling or sublicensing**

You do not resell, sublicense, or hand off the platform or codebase to another company.

- **No reverse-engineering**

You do not attempt to reverse-engineer, copy, or reconstruct the underlying source code.

- **Brand pack is for your operation**

Your brand pack is used to run your own company, not to create a competing or resold product.
